



NEW EAST VALLEY DIAL-A-RIDE PARATRANSIT FARES

EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2010

On July 1, 2009, a new Valley Metro fare policy went into effect. This included a phased increase to the East Valley Dial-a-Ride fares annually until 2 times the local bus cash fare is reached. The new fare structure is designed to help maintain transit service. Service cuts may occur with the ongoing decline in sales tax revenues. Sales taxes provide a majority of the funding for bus and light rail service.

ADA DIAL-A-RIDE FARE PRICING*

Current ADA Fare: \$2.50

July 1, 2010 Fare*: \$3.00

Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Paratransit Dial-A-Ride fares must keep pace with the bus/light rail fares. In the East Valley, the ADA Dial-A-Ride fares are \$3.00 beginning July 1, 2010 with an increase of \$.50 on July 1, 2011 when the ADA fare will reach \$3.50. Please note that non-ADA fares for East Valley Dial-A-Ride are not increasing.

In Phoenix, ADA Paratransit Dial-A-Ride fares are two times the local bus fare or \$3.50. For seniors and persons with disabilities using non-ADA services, fares are as follows: \$2.50 for same day/first zone fare and \$1.50 for same day/each additional zone.
