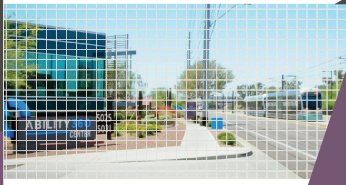

## Community Support

Valley Metro and the City of Phoenix have dedicated professionals to help residents and businesses through construction. These points of contact will notify you regularly, in advance of construction activity, and respond to your concerns. They are available 24/7.

In addition, specific programs and staff are brought on board to directly support the business community. A custom business assistance program is in development to provide resources to help businesses within the project area stay well-positioned during construction.

Construction on the 50th St/Washington Valley Metro Rail station begins in early June 2017. The station is the first light rail project funded by Phoenix's Transportation 2050 and will enhance future development and provide convenient access to Ability360 and neighboring businesses.

## 2017 Construction Schedule

- Construction begins on June 8 on Washington Street between 48th and 50th streets.
- Work occurs Monday through Friday, from approximately 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Traffic restrictions will remain in place after construction hours due to nature of work.

## SAFETY TIPS

Allow for extra travel time



Follow traffic signals and message boards



Always use designated crosswalks



Limit distractions such as cell phones and headphones

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Access to businesses will be available at all times.
- At least one westbound and eastbound lane will remain open to vehicle traffic.
- A fully accessible alternative pedestrian lane will be available.
- Bicycle lanes will be closed.
