## About the Project

The 11-mile Capitol/I-10 West light rail extension will connect with the existing Valley Metro Rail system in downtown Phoenix, to the 79th Avenue park-and-ride.

In 2015, the Phoenix City Council and Valley Metro Rail Board of Directors approved a phased approach to the project. Phase I will connect downtown Phoenix to the State Capitol area and Phase II will extend light rail along I-10 to 79th Avenue.



### PROJECT STATUS

Valley Metro is working on the draft Environmental Assessment (EA) for the project (both phases) for submittal to the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) in early 2018, which will include an opportunity for public review of the EA.

### NEXT STEPS

Following approval of the Environmental Assessment, Valley Metro and the city of Phoenix will be eligible to compete for additional federal funding. Those funds could be used for the design, construction and operation of Phase I of the project and provide opportunities to accelerate the Phase II schedule.
