About the Project

Valley Metro has initiated a feasibility study to evaluate corridor options to connect the Paradise Valley Mall area with the existing light rail system. Two corridor options were identified through the following voter-approved plans:

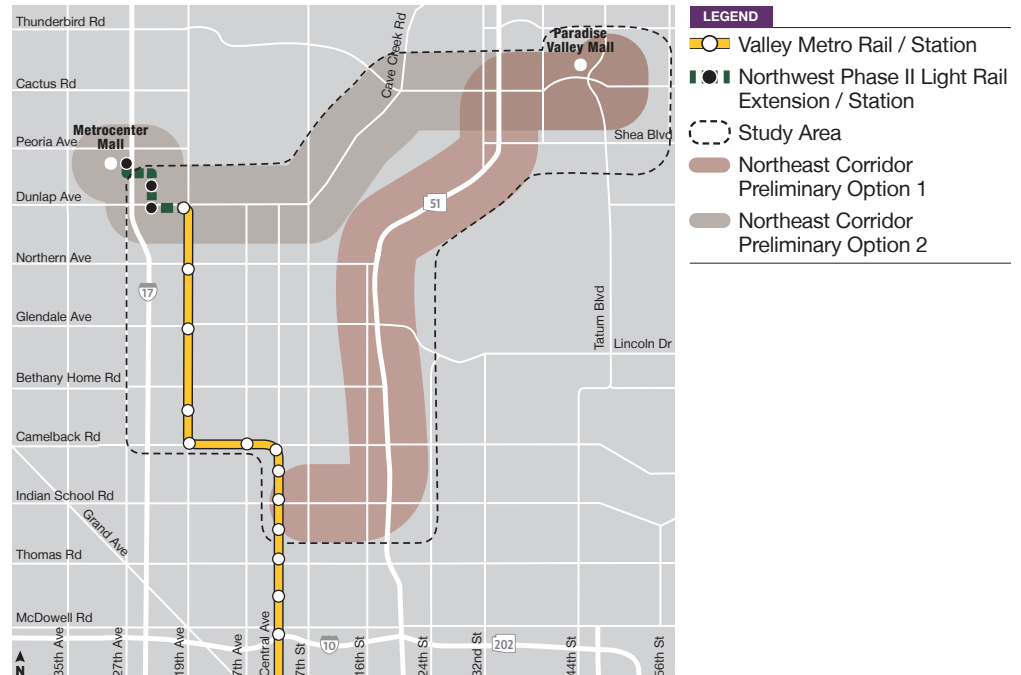
- **Option 1** – the 2004 Regional Transportation Plan identified a 12-mile corridor in the State Route 51 area
- **Option 2** – the 2015 Phoenix Transportation 2050 Plan identified an alternate 8-mile corridor connecting the Metrocenter Mall area to Paradise Valley Mall through the Sunnyslope corridor

Feasibility studies are the first step in the planning process with a goal to identify the most feasible option(s) for potential further analysis.

PROJECT STATUS

- Valley Metro, in coordination with the city of Phoenix, is evaluating each corridor option on potential ridership, costs and funding options, engineering constraints and economic development potential.

NEXT STEPS

Through mid 2018, Valley Metro will complete its evaluation and prepare a final report. In the future, next steps may include more detailed study to evaluate options for the transit route and type, such as light rail or bus rapid transit, as well as further engagement with the community.
