## Let's Get to Work

The South Central Extension/Downtown Hub will connect with the current light rail system in downtown Phoenix and operate south to Baseline Road. The project also includes a light rail transit hub in downtown Phoenix, new stations and public art.

Construction activities began in October 2019 starting in the downtown area. In early 2020, utility relocation will begin along Central Avenue. The complete construction timeline is being developed and will be communicated as the project progresses, including the details about where and when construction work will occur.

Each phase of construction has specific characteristics regarding when and where the work occurs. The projected is expected to open for operations in 2024.

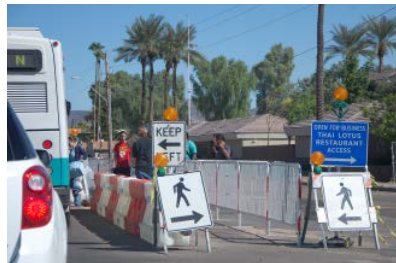

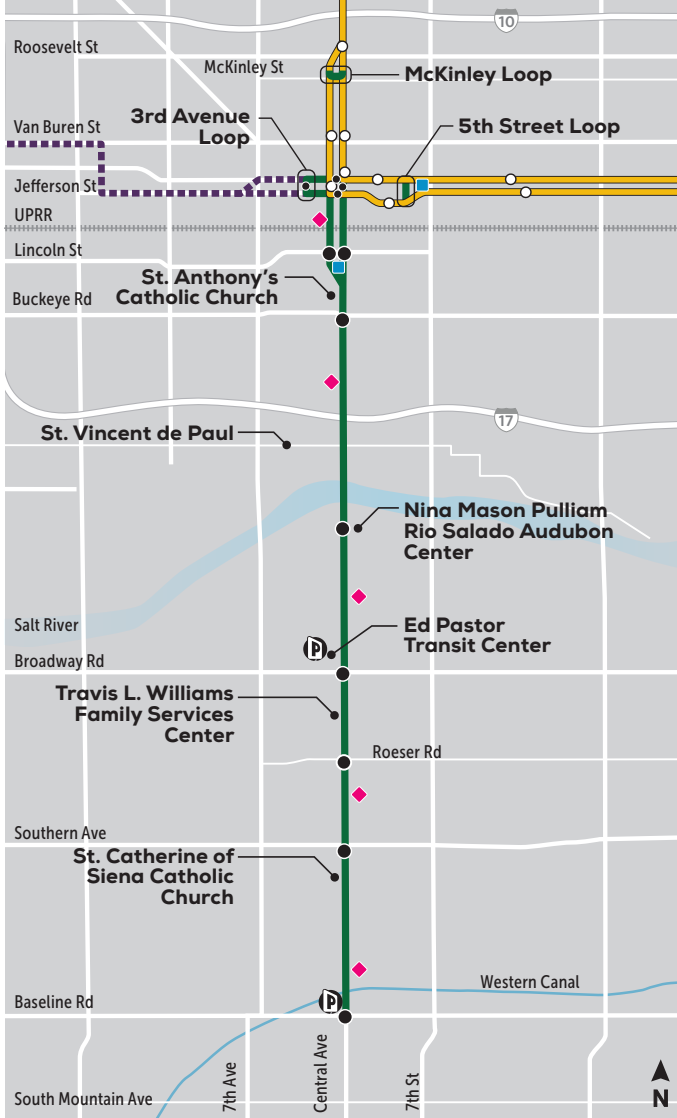

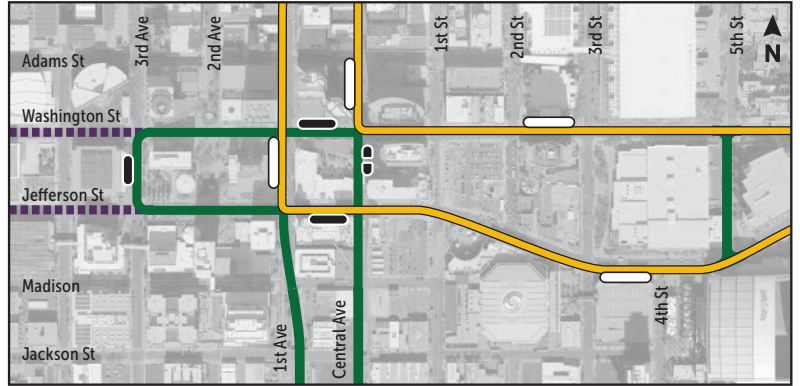

Valley Metro is committed to minimizing construction impacts and maintaining a safe environment.
